



Monongalia County Schools Pre-K/Head Start Program Is Currently Accepting Applications For The 2018-2019 School Year Through Appointment

Children must be 4 on or before June 30, 2018 to apply.

To apply, you will need:

- ✓ **Your Child's Certificate of Live Birth from the State Dept./Vital Statistics Office**
- ✓ **Your Child's Record of Immunizations**
- ✓ **One Proof of Residency – Utility bill, purchase/rental agreement, etc.**
- ✓ **2017 Income Verification to secure Head Start slot eligibility**

Additional Documentation Needed Prior to the Beginning of School:

- ✓ **4 Year Health Check**
- ✓ **Current Dental Exam**

IMPORTANT IF YOU ARE WISHING TO HAVE YOUR CHILD PARTICIPATE IN THE PK LOTTERY, ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED PRIOR TO 4/15/18.

Head Start is a free early childhood program open to all age eligible children. Families who meet Head Start Income Guidelines will receive priority for Head Start designated slots.
